STUDENT CLASSIFICATION

PROCEDURE 5.2.1.1

- A. A full-time student is a student enrolled in a given semester with twelve (12) or more semester hours of credit. Registration in excess of 20 credit hours within a semester (10 hours in a single term), including contact hours or pre-curriculum courses, requires written permission of the student's academic advisor and the appropriate Associate Dean. A part-time student is a student enrolled with fewer than twelve (12) semester hours of credit. For Financial Aid purposes, aid may be pro-rated if a student is enrolled with fewer than twelve (12) semester hours of credit. A freshman is a student who has earned fewer than 30 semester hours of credit and a sophomore is a student who has earned more than 30 hours of credit
- **B.** A student enrolled in a College program and receiving Department of Veteran Affairs benefits is required to carry 12 credit hours in course work each semester in order to receive full educational benefits. Any student enrolled for 3/4 or 1/2 of the full-time requirements as mentioned above is eligible for proportionate compensation. Students enrolled less than 1/2 time are compensated for in-state tuition and fees only. Verification of attendance for veterans is required.
