Thanks for registering for the course **Motorcycle Rider Safety**. In order to help you have a successful experience on our campus, the following information is provided:

Classroom sessions will meet on our Thomasville Campus in the Public Safety Bldg. A map has been included for your convenience. This class will teach you safety skills that will enable you to reduce your tension and enjoy motorcycling more. Many self-taught riders are not aware of the skills you will be learning that are designed to minimize chances of accidents or injuries. Successful completion of this course will exempt you from having to take the riding portion of the DMV Motorcycle Endorsement test. In addition, many insurance companies offer premium discounts for successful graduates of this course.

The College will provide the motorcycles for this training. Listed below are items you will need to wear when riding the range portion of the course. You will not need these items on Thursday night.

- A helmet (Optional – will be provided)
- Long sleeves; a shirt or a jacket
- Long pants
- Full-fingered gloves
- Leather boots or shoes that cover the ankles
- Eye protection (eyeglasses or sunglasses), or a full-faced helmet or face shield
- Headphones/Ear Buds (Optional – will be provided for E-Course Learning)

If you don't have a helmet, the College has a limited supply. In addition, it may be necessary to dress for inclement weather, however, as a general rule rain will not delay or cancel riding instruction.

Please call the Registration and Records office at (336) 224-4545, as soon as possible if you are unable to attend so that your slot can be filled. Our office hours are Monday-Thursday 8 a.m.-7:30 p.m. and on Friday from 8 a.m.-5 p.m.
