

DDCC Course Section Designation

DDCC uses a combination of numbers and letters to denote the meeting times, locations, and delivery types of a course section. *For example: a section labeled ENG-111-1DYNA would meet the first eight weeks of the semester, be offered at the Davie Campus, be delivered as a hybrid course, meet after 4:00 p.m., and be the A section.*

When registering for sections, please check the times, dates and locations.

Times

- 1 + A, B, C, D ... Fall/Spring 1 (*First-Eight Weeks*) Section
- 2 + A, B, C, D ... Fall/Spring 2 (*Second-Eight Weeks*) Section
- 5 + A, B, C, D ... Any section that is not eight or 16 weeks in length

Note: Full semester length sections (16 weeks) do not have a number designation.

Locations

- D + A, B, C, D ... Davie Campus
- Q + A, B, C, D ... Section Offered at Local High School
- T + A, B, C, D ... Thomasville Education Center
- U + A, B, C, D ... Uptown Lexington Education Center
- K + A, B, C, D ... Davie Education Center (Kinderton)

Note: Sections taught on the Davidson Campus do not have a Location letter.

Delivery Method

- F + A, B, C, D ... Hyflex (*a choice of in-person sessions or an online option*)
- Y + A, B, C, D ... Hybrid (*some meetings or exams on campus + some online*)
- W + A, B, C, D ... Online Section
- V + A, B, C, D ... Virtual Meeting Section

Types (*If a section has a combination of Types, they should appear in the order listed.*)

- N + A, B, C, D ... Evening (*section offered after 4:00 p.m.*)
- I + A, B, C, D ... Independent Study
- S + A, B, C, D ... Saturday Section
- Z + A, B, C, D ... Challenge Exam

Letter Designation

A, B, C, D... Section Letter Designation (*different letters denote different sections of the same course; these can stand alone or be combined with other Types*)
